2. Pre-Acceptance Letter

Academic Essay Writing & Reading Skills

From generating a strong, debatable thesis, to detailed editing and final submission, each week of the curriculum focuses on an academic essay style (persuasive, argumentative etc.) combined with a structural focus (thesis, body paragraphs, works cited). The essays are held to MLA standards.

Presentation Skills

Pathway students produce twelve academic presentations in the program. Each week, a presentation skill is focused on. Presentations and projects in the Pathway Program need to reflect the reality of the tools available. Students become Keynote experts, weaving between multiple apps and techniques to best execute their project requirements. Time management is also key, as students are educated on how to best manage their time throughout the process of creating a project and/or presentation.



Group Work

Our Pathway Program often reflects the standard University tutorial setup, with active listening, turn-taking, and elaboration skills in constant use and refinement. Critical thinking is explored in small and large groups daily, and a series of group work activities each week prepare them for working and collaborating with native speakers at the University level.

Research Skills

Thesis development and paraphrasing are consistently reinforced to meet the Academic Honesty standards of the Modern Language Association. Improved research and information-management skills are demanded.

CELPIP Preparation Course
